Jiajie Zhang, Ph.D. is dean, professor, and The Glassell Family Foundation Distinguished Chair in Informatics Excellence at UTHealth® Houston School of Biomedical Informatics. In addition, he is a Fellow of the American College of Medical Informatics (FACMI), the American Medical Informatics Association (FAMIA), and the International Academy of Health Sciences Informatics (FIAHSI). Dr. Zhang is the former director of the National Center for Cognitive Informatics and Decision Making in Healthcare (NCCD), and led the Office of the National Coordinator for Health IT (ONC) SHARPC project focused on enhancing patient-centered cognitive support in EHR and Health IT. He has more than 30 years of research, education, and application experiences in Biomedical and Health Informatics, Cognitive Science, Human Technology Integration, Decision Making, and Machine Learning.
